Captain Mark B. Zinderman will address attendees. Captain Mark B. Zinderman is currently serving as an active guard reserve officer with the U.S. Army National Guard, in the 29th Combat Aviation Brigade. He also recently served as a New York State Trooper from 2013 to 2018, patrolling in the Town's of Lagrange, Beekman, Unionvale, Clinton, Stanford, and Pleasant Valley.

A native of Kingston, New York, Captain Zinderman graduated from Kingston Senior High School, and attended Norwich University Military College in Vermont. He received his commission in the U.S. Army National Guard as a 2nd Lieutenant in 2006, and has twelve years of service with the military.

Currently, he is in Command of Company C, 1-169th Aviation, a UH-60 Blackhawk air medical evacuation unit, based out of Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland. In 2012 he deployed to Afghanistan as a pilot with this unit, in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. His mission there was to provide air medical evacuation to U.S. and Coalition Forces, as well as local nationals located within Helmand Province. He conducted numerous medical evacuation missions during this time, primarily transporting U.S. Marine Corps casualties operating within the region.
