SHARE YOUR FEEDBACK: Open House on Intersection Improvement Projects to be Held at Lagrange Town Hall on February 26th

The Dutchess County Department of Public Works has performed a study for potential improvements to the intersections of Red Oaks Mill Road (CR 44) with Titusville Road (CR 49) and Walker Road (CR 44S)/Cochran Hill Road in the Town of Lagrange. There will be an open house at the Lagrange Town Hall on Wednesday, February 26th. All are welcome to attend any time between 6-8pm.

For each intersection, a roundabout and non-roundabout design have been developed that will reduce congestion, improve traffic flow and increase the safety of the intersections for motorists. After collecting and reviewing feedback on each project, the DPW Engineering Division will then complete the final design phase. Construction of one or both projects would be funding dependent.

Materials about each project will be shared at the open house and project staff will be on hand to hear feedback and answer questions.
